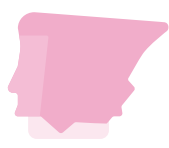

ANNUAL MEETINGS

- Exchange of information on adaptation strategies and plans.
- Identification of adaptation measures to be developed jointly.
- Acknowledgement of coordination needs among Iberian authorities and agents.



THEMED TECHNICAL SEMINARS

- Cross-border seminars with technical officers, researchers and representatives from both countries
- Major forums held over two days to discuss and reflect on a specific topic.

ORGANIZATION

- **ORGANIZING COMMITTEE:** prepare the provisional programme, agree on the dates and format of the conference, manage initial logistical details, etc.
- **TECHNICAL COMMITTEE:** finalize the programme and propose speakers, and select experiences in accordance with the goals set out for each themed session.
- **THEMED SESSIONS:** varied and with the aid of coordination, speaker, facilitation and online collaborative and networking tools (sli.do and spatial. chat).
- **SPEAKERS** from a wide range of fields (scientists, professionals of vulnerable sectors, representatives of public administrations, educators, media, etc.).
